### SCOUTING GEORGIA STATE

The Panthers enter tonight's contest at 6-1 overall with a 3-0 mark on the road, and have won their last five straight. Senior forward Danyiell McKeller is averaging 20.9 points and 6.3 rebounds per game to lead the team in both categories. McKeller's classmate, Shay Rawls, also grabs 6.3 boards per night while adding 4.1 ppg. Juniors Angelique Burtt (12.7 ppg) and Chan Harris (11.0) round out the players averaging double figures. Georgia State is currently second in the Colonial Athletic Conference standings after garnering an 11th place preseason ranking. Head coach Lea Henry is in her sixteenth year at the helm of the Panthers.

**DIRECTIONS TO IONA COLLEGE**

**From Hutchinson River Parkway Southbound**

Exit 18E, Mill Road. Right on Mill Road to light, then right on North Avenue. Follow North Avenue 2 miles to gates of College on your left.

**From Hutchinson River Parkway Northbound**

Exit 14, turn right at the light off the exit. Turn left on Eastchester Road to the end, then right on North Avenue to second traffic light and left onto campus.

**From I-95 North and Southbound**

Exit 16. Follow signs to North Avenue. Right onto North Avenue, proceed one mile to gates of the college on your right.

**From I-87 North and Southbound**

Exit at Cross County Parkway East, proceed to Exit 10, New Rochelle Road, Eastchester. Turn right and proceed to fourth traffic light. Turn left on Eastchester Road to the end, then right on North Avenue to second traffic light and left onto campus.

**THE HEAD COACH**

Head coach **Anthony Bozzella** is in his eighth year on the sidelines with the Gaels. In his time at Iona, his teams have compiled a 93-127 record. Now in his 18th season as a collegiate head coach, Bozzella owns a career mark of 247-258 that includes eight years at Southampton and two years at Long Island.

**THE STAFF**

**Christi Abbate** is in her eighth year at Iona and 13th on **Anthony Bozzella's** staff. She was promoted to Associate Head Coach prior to the 2006-07 season. Assistant Coach **Ashlee Kelly** is a new face on the sidelines this season. **Toni Horvath** serves her second season as an Assistant Coach and is in her second year on the staff, while former Gael **Jessica Anger** returns to in the role as Director of Basketball Operations.

**PRESEASON NUMBER TWO**

Iona was picked to finish second in the Preseason MAAC Coaches' Poll, following the loss of just one senior from the 2008-09 squad. It is the second highest preseason ranking the Gaels have ever received. In 2006-07, Iona was picked first and finished the season in second. Iona also had a school-record four players chosen for the Preseason All-MAAC Teams. Senior co-captain **Thazina Cook** was named Preseason First Team All-MAAC while **Anna McLean**, **Anda Ivkovic**, and **Kristina Ford** were all named to the Second Team.

**IONA IN MAAC PLAY**

Since the beginning of the 2005-06 MAAC season, Iona has posted a 47-25 record against the league. The 47 wins are the second most by any of the ten conference members, behind Marist's 67.

**GAELS IN THE USA**

Three Gaels are among the NCAA's nationally ranked women's basketball leaders. **Suzi Fregosi** is ranked 6<sup>th</sup> in assist-to-turnover ratio, 30<sup>th</sup> in assists per game, and 21<sup>st</sup> in steals per game.

**Anna McLean** is ranked 50<sup>th</sup> in FG% and 49<sup>th</sup> in rebounds per game. **Thazina Cook** is ranked 195<sup>th</sup> in rebounds per game and 236<sup>th</sup> in three-point field goals per game.

**FACING NEW HIGHS**

At the time of their meeting with Iona, Notre Dame was ranked at No. 5 in the AP Top 25 women's basketball national poll, making the Irish the highest ranked opponent the Gaels have ever faced.

**500 AND COUNTING**

Iona's contest against Pacific on Nov. 20 marked Anthony Bozzella's 500th career game as a head coach. Bozzella led the Gaels in a 76-54 victory to earn his 246th career win.

**IONA AND THE PACIFIC-10**

The Nov. 14th game against Arizona marked the first time Iona had ever hosted a Pacific-10 conference team, and was just the third time in history the Gaels had faced a team from the Pac-10 (0-3). Iona will be returning to the west coast next season to visit Arizona as well as Northern Arizona.

**COMING UP ON A THOUSAND**

At 19th all-time with 999 career points, **Thazina Cook** needs one more point to become the 19th player in school history to reach the 1,000 point mark.

**BOUNDING UP THE CHART**

**Anna McLean** is currently 6th all-time at Iona with 696 career rebounds. With four more boards, she will become the program's sixth player to ever reach 700 rebounds.

NOTRE DAME, IN - The Iona College women's basketball team took on No. 5 Notre Dame in its 2009-10 road opener in front of a crowd of 8,511 at Purcell Pavilion. The Gaels, facing their highest ranked opponent ever, were defeated by the Irish, 80-45.

Trailing 4-0 to start the Game, Iona (2-2) scored its first points on an inside basket by Anna McLean at 18:43. Notre Dame (3-0) then put up seven unanswered to push the lead to 11-2. Back-to-back layups by Anda Ivkovic and McLean helped the Gaels pull back to within five, the closest they would get in the game.

The Fighting Irish surged to a 38-24 halftime advantage and held the Maroon & Gold to 29.2% shooting in the second half to win by 35. Notre Dame's high pressure defense forced a Iona to commit a season-high 33 turnovers which led to 34 points off turnovers for the Irish.

Thazina Cook led the Gaels with 12 points and ten rebounds for a double-double while adding three steals. McLean finished with ten points and grabbed six boards.

**Game 5 Arkansas 66, Iona College 60 (2-3) Non-Conference Game Caribbean Challenge Moon Palace Resort, Cancun, Mex. November 26, 2009**

CANCUN, MEXICO - In the first of two games at the Caribbean Challenge presented by Triple Crown Sports, the Iona College women's basketball team lost a 66-60 nail biter to Arkansas. Senior Anna McLean led the Gaels with 15 points and 11 rebounds in a game that became a tale of two halves.

"This has been a great experience for us so far, and we look forward to bouncing back tomorrow," said head coach Anthony Bozzella. "We really appreciate our school allowing us the opportunity to participate in something like this."

Iona (2-3) shot 46.2% in the first half and went an impressive 6-for-10 from three point range. With the game tied at six, rookie Diana Hubbard hit her second of four trifectas to give the Maroon & Gold a three point lead at the 15:16 mark. The Gaels stayed comfortably in front for the rest of the half, leading by as much as nine points with 1:55 to go. At the break, Iona had a 36-28 advantage.

The second half saw a significant turn-around as the Gaels banked just 22.2% in the period to Arkansas' 46.4%.
